Dear Resident:

Some of the residents in your neighborhood have requested that PSNC Energy run a natural gas line to their property. In order to accomplish this, we would need to extend our gas main past your property. If you are interested in converting any of your appliances to natural gas, this would be an appropriate time to talk with us.

Please indicate on the enclosed survey form the appliances you would convert or connect within 90 days, if the gas line was run to your home. Please return this survey form to me at your earliest convenience. I will then perform a feasibility study, comparing estimated revenues of committed appliances against the cost of extending our gas main and service lines in your area.

This feasibility study is used to determine whether the customer would be required to contribute to the cost of extending such lines. The feasibility study is based on the distance required to be piped, the number of new customers that would be added to the customer base, and the appliances installed at the time we run the gas lines to your home.

PLEASE NOTE: I cannot provide an estimated cost to you for this project until I gather the information from the enclosed survey forms and perform the feasibility study. At that time, I will contact you with the results and any associated cost, and then the decision will be made by the homeowners as to whether or not to proceed with the project. Construction will not begin until PSNC Energy and the homeowners are all in agreement to proceed.

Any appliance conversion or replacement would be at the home owner's expense through a contractor of their choice.
